**Update! – Alpha 2017**  
Praise the Lord for His Wonderful Guidance: we had completed half of the Alpha Course where 42 (7 English, 3 Mandarin & 32 Cantonese Speaking) guests and 8 kids were reached & served in the 5 Alpha sessions: which had far exceeded our originally planned (18 guests) capacity!  
To summarize: we had 25 guests/4 kids attended the first night (29/9): 21 guests/7 kids attended the second night (13/10), 18 guests/5 kids attended the third night (20/10) and 15 guests/3 kids attended the 4th night (27/10) and 25 guests/6 kids attended the fifth program, and Praise God that broke our guests/kids attendance record again. Together with the Alpha Team and supporters, we had 55 people joined the 5th session's dinner and the 4 small groups' discussion.  
We are thrilled to hear that one guest accepted Christ the day after the 5th session. Please continue to pray earnestly for him and also for all guests that their hearts are touched by the His messages and by the love of God revealed in Jesus and manifested through His Body - the followers of Jesus connected in this Alpha.  
We are thankful to have 26 Alpha Team members signed up one of the three Prayer Ministry Training sessions (7/11, 11/11, 14/11) to be equipped to minister to our guests through praying in the Holy Spirit during the Alpha Day Camp.  
Praise Lord Jesus that we already had 60 people signed up for the Day Retreat (22 guests, 7 kids & 31 helpers/supporters). Pray that our guests are willing to receive the prayer ministry, open their hearts to be filled and transformed by the Holy Spirit when they accept Jesus Christ as their savior and their Lord.
